

### **Fisheries Act Authorization**



Fisheries Act

34.4 (1) No person shall carry on any work, undertaking or activity, other than fishing, that results in the death of fish.

Exception

(2) A person may carry on a work, undertaking or activity without contravening subsection (1) if

(a) ..

(b) the carrying on of the work, undertaking or activity is **authorized by the Minister** and the work, undertaking or activity is carried on in accordance with the conditions established by the Minister



Potential Harmful Alteration, Disruption or Destruction of Fish Habitat



Is included in the list of "prescribe works" and the work is carried out under specific codes of practice

Metal and Diamond Mine Effluent Regulation (MDMER) Schedule 2 Amendment



**MDMER** 

**5 (1)** Despite section 4, the owner or operator of a mine may deposit or permit the deposit of **waste rock**, acutely lethal effluent or effluent of any pH and containing any concentration of a deleterious substance that is prescribed in section 3 into a tailings impoundment area that is either

- (a) a water or place set out in Schedule 2; or
- **(b)** a disposal area that is confined by anthropogenic or natural structures or by both, other than a disposal area that is, or is part of, a natural water body that is frequented by fish.

Permit to Take Water (PTTW)



Ontario Water Resources Act

#### Water taking

34 (1) Despite any other Act, a person shall **not take more** than 50,000 litres of water on any day by any means except in accordance with a **permit** issued under section 34.1.



Taking of any water in excess of 50,000 lpd from Surface or Groundwater source



Specifically listed activities, including:

- Firefighting and emergencies
- Wetland conservation
- Domestic purposes

Environmental Activity Sector Registry (EASR)



#### Environmental Protection Act

**20.21** (1) Subject to subsections (2), (3) and (4), no person shall engage in an activity at a site **if the activity has been prescribed by the regulations** for the purposes of this subsection unless,

(a) the person has **registered the activity in the Registry** in accordance with the regulations;



### Activities in O. Reg. 63/16

e.g. Highway Projects, Transit Projects, Construction Projects, Pump Tests



- Mining/Mine exploration/Mine Rehabilitation
- Aggregate Pits or Quarries

- Industrial Sewage Works
- Municipal and Private Sewage Works



Ontario Water Resources Act

Approval of Director for sewage works

53 (1) No person shall use, operate, establish, alter, extend or replace new or existing sewage works except under and in accordance with an environmental compliance approval.



Use, operate, establish, alter, extend or replace new or existing sewage works (>10,000 LPD)

Sewage works = works for the collection, transmission, treatment or disposal of sewage. Sewage = drainage, storm water, commercial wastes and industrial wastes

**Work Permits** 



Public Lands Act

14(1) The Lieutenant Governor in Council may make regulations,

a) governing activities that may be carried out on public lands and on shore lands, including requiring that such activities be carried out in accordance with the regulations and prohibiting certain activities on public lands or shore lands unless the activity is carried out in accordance with the terms and conditions of a work permit.



Trigger

Activity that encroaches on water on public lands or shorelands:

e.g. Ditch that ties into body of water, pipeline that discharges to a stream, culvert installation

Lakes and Rivers Improvement Act Authorization – Location Approval and Plans and Specifications Approval



Lakes and Rivers Improvement Act

14 (1) No person shall construct a dam in any lake or river in circumstances set out in the regulations without the written approval of the Minister for the location of the dam and its plans and specifications.





### **Construction of Water Retaining Structures**

e.g. Dams, Dikes, Diversion Ditches

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# **CONSERVATION AUTHORITIES**



**CA Approvals** 



#### Conservation Authorities Act

- 8 (1) Subject to the approval of the Minister, an authority may make regulations applicable in the area under its jurisdiction,
- (b) prohibiting, regulating or requiring the permission of the authority for straightening, changing, diverting or interfering in any way with the existing channel of a river, creek, stream or watercourse, or for changing or interfering in any way with a wetland;
- (c) prohibiting, regulating or requiring the permission of the authority for development if, in the opinion of the authority, the control of flooding, erosion, dynamic beaches or pollution or the conservation of land may be affected by the development;
